

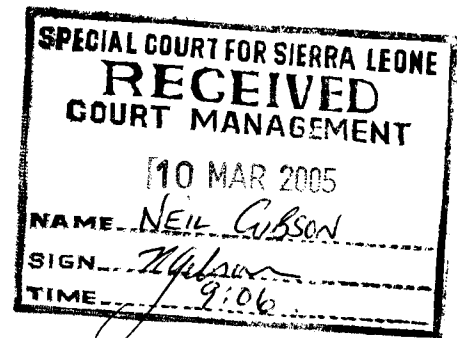



1. In view of the “Combined Prosecution Response to Kanu and Brima – Motion to Disclose Prosecution Materials and/or Other Information Pertaining to Rewards Provided to Prosecution Trial Witnesses,” of March 7, 2005 the Defense in the case of both Kanu and Brima inform the Trial Chamber that it no longer seeks a ruling on this issue.
2. The Defence observes that, prior to the evidence in chief of each witness, the Prosecution has indeed disclosed the record of payments made to its witnesses.
3. The Defence further observes that, having met with and discussed matters with the Senior Trial Attorney for the Prosecution on March 9, 2005. The Defence is satisfied that there is no issue between the parties in relation to this aspect of disclosure.
