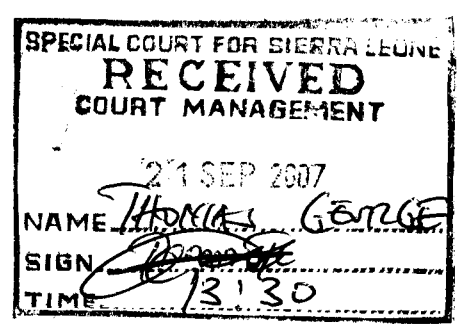




1. The Defence for all three Convicted Persons, and the Prosecution, jointly file this motion, seeking an order extending the time limit under Rule 112 for the filing of all parties' response briefs.
2. In the "Joint Defence and Prosecution Motion for an Extension of Time For the Filing of Appeal Briefs", filed jointly by the Defence for all three Convicted Persons and the Prosecution on 2 August 2007, it was foreshadowed that after the Appeal Briefs in this case had been filed, the parties would consult with a view to establishing whether there is a common view that an extension of time of a particular length is necessary for the response briefs.
3. In view of the length of the Appeal Briefs that were filed, the parties are in agreement that they require until 8 October 2007 to complete their response briefs, which is an extension of 11 days. The parties hereby respectfully request an extension of time until that date.
