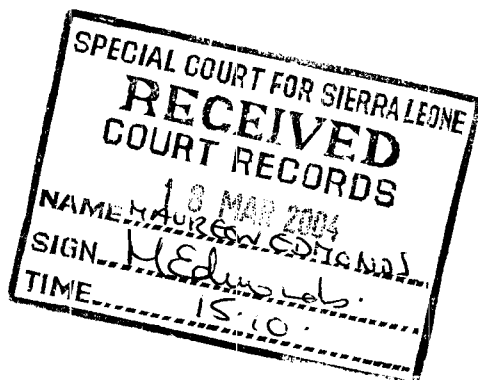




This document is filed on behalf of the Defendant Sam Hinga Norman in response to the Prosecutor's Request ("the Request") to Admit dated 5th March 2004.


The Defendant Sam Hinga Norman after careful consideration rejects the Request and does not admit or concede any facts stated therein.
