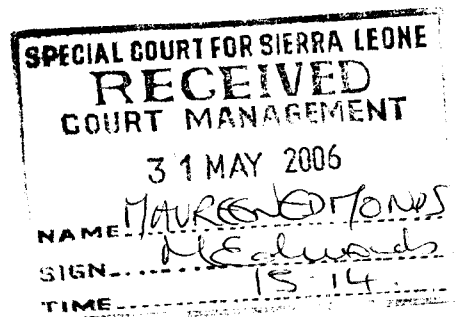

SUBMISSIONS

1. Counsel for the Second Accused, Mr Moinina Fofana, (the “Defence”) hereby submits its reply to the ‘Prosecution Response to the Fofana Application for Right of Audience for Mr Andrew Ianuzzi’ filed on 30 May 2006¹.
2. In light of the events which transpired in court this morning, the Defence acknowledges the suggestion advanced by the Office of the Prosecutor in its Response as a prudent one². Accordingly, in order to ensure Mr Fofana’s fully informed consent and to avoid further accusations against Mr Ianuzzi by the Office of the Principal Defender³, the Defence submits that it would be advisable for a member of the Principal Defender’s staff to obtain Mr Fofana’s written waiver. The Defence is prepared to cooperate in this regard.
3. For the reasons advanced in its Application, the Defence respectfully requests the Chamber to issue its decision as soon as possible so the Defence may proceed with its case preparation accordingly.
