

- 1. The Defence files this motion pursuant to Rule 7 bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules") to request that the Trial Chamber grant an extension of time for the filing of preliminary motions in this case.
- 2. On 15th July 2011 Justice Doherty, at the preliminary hearing in respect of this matter, ruled that the Defence be allowed 25 days from the date on which the Independent Prosecutor provided disclosure to file and preliminary motions. The Defence were also given liberty to apply in respect of timing on any preliminary matters.
- 3. The Defence propose to file a joint motion in respect of preliminary matters relating primarily, but not exclusively to jurisdiction. Logistically it has proved impossible to file within the 25 days currently permitted as one of our number is currently in Rwanda carrying out investigations from a Defence perspective which may impact proposed the proposed motion.
- 4. Accordingly the Defence respectfully requests an extension of twenty one days for the filing of preliminary motions pursuant to Rule 7 *bis*. It is not believed that any prejudice will be caused to the Prosecution or any other party to these proceedings by said extension.
