

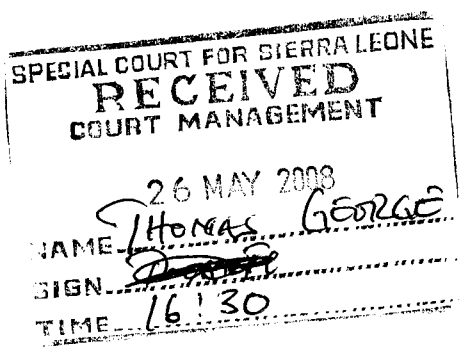



The Kallon Defence seeks leave to amend previous filings dated 23 May 2008<sup>1</sup> and 26 May 2008<sup>2</sup> insofar as there is a reference to Rule 92*ter* in the cover page and in paragraph 13, in addition the statements of Buhari Musa (DMK-400), which was filed as a public document should be withdrawn and replaced with a copy of the statement filed confidentially on 23 May 2008 without the use of pseudonyms.
2. Kallon Defence erroneously included in the filing of 26 May 2008 the Buhari Musa statement which had not been edited to remove contentious issues between the Prosecution and the Defence.
3. The Kallon Defence seeks admission of the two statements under Rule 92*bis* only.
