

Introduction



#### Introduction

1. Following the Order of 7<sup>th</sup> March 2007, Court Appointed Counsel for Augustine Gbao hereby files a public version of its Defence Materials.

## **Procedural History**

- 2. On 30 October 2006, the Trial Chamber ordered each of the defence teams to file, by the 16<sup>th</sup> February 2007, the following documents:<sup>2</sup>
  - a. A "core" and "back up" witness list;
  - b. An indication as to whether the Accused will testify at trial;
  - c. A list of expert witnesses;
  - d. An indication of common witnesses;
  - e. A list of exhibits;
  - f. A chart indicating, for each paragraph of the indictment, the testimonial and documentary evidence upon which the Defence will rely to defend the Accused against the allegations contained therein.
- 3. In addition, the Trial Chamber requested each of the defence teams to submit a joint agreement of agreed facts and matters which are not in dispute, as well as a joint statement of contested matters of fact and law.<sup>3</sup>
- 4. Finally, the Trial Chamber scheduled a Pre-Defence Conference for the 20<sup>th</sup> of March 2007.
- 5. On 7<sup>th</sup> February 2007, the Trial Chamber, following a request by the defence teams, <sup>5</sup> granted an



extension of time and ordered the above mentioned materials to be filed no later than 5<sup>th</sup> March 2007, 4:00pm.

- 6. On 27<sup>th</sup> February 2007, the Trial Chamber granted the request by the Sesay defence team for an extension of time to file the Joint Statement of Agreed Facts<sup>6</sup> and ordered the defence teams to file this joint statement no later than 7 days after the return of the Accused Issa Hassan Sesay in the jurisdiction of the Special Court.<sup>7</sup> On 2 March 2007, this team filed a request for an extension of time in this respect, in case the Chamber disagreed with our interpretation of its Orders.<sup>8</sup>
- 7. On 7<sup>th</sup> March 2007, the Trial Chamber ordered the Gbao defence team to file a public version of its defence materials to be made available to the public.<sup>9</sup>

### **Testimony of the Accused on Trial**

8. Pursuant to the Scheduling Order, the Chamber seeks an indication as to whether the Accused will testify. <sup>10</sup> It is not yet decided whether this would serve the interests of the Accused. This decision requires further consultation with the Accused in the light of all the evidence. Without wishing to compromise legal privilege, the Defence can indicate that there are as yet unresolved issues which need to be settled before this decision can be made. The Chamber will be aware of the delicate nature of the lawyer client relationship (as evidenced by the history of the proceedings). Addressing this issue with the Accused requires careful consideration of what his testimony can add, as well as extreme caution and patience in ensuring that the Accused fully understands the implications. The relationship between counsel and the Accused has improved significantly and this position must be preserved at all costs at this critical stage in the

proceedings. In Counsel's submission, to force the issue now would be inconsistent with the Accused right to testify.

9. The Defence therefore wishes, with the leave of the Chamber, to reserve its decision as to whether the Accused will testify until later in the proceedings. However, if the Chamber deems that the Gbao defence team must be compelled to make a statement on this, then

the Gbao defence team states for the record that the Accused will testify, reserving its right to change that position and making it clear at the same time that this is not a fully considered or firm position.

### **Expert Witnesses**

10. At this stage of the proceedings, this defence team has not decided upon any particular expert. Indeed, satisfactory experts have not yet been identified. In addition, the team is concerned not to duplicate or undermine the expert testimony of the first two Accused. The team will continue to search for appropriate experts, produce reports as quickly as possible but preferably in the light of other Defence expert testimony and where appropriate seek the leave of the Chamber to call those experts. However, we can indicate at this stage that, subject to our evaluation of other expert testimony put forward by other Accused, we intend to identify and use an expert on the nature of guerrilla movements with particular reference to the RUF.

#### **Common Witness List**

11. The defence team for Augustine Gbao filed a motion for non disclosure of the witnesses' names to the other defence teams on 14 February 2007.<sup>11</sup> Following the decision by the Trial Chamber, <sup>12</sup> the defence team for Augustine Gbao will not share the witnesses' information with the other RUF defence teams and therefore is in the impossibility of participating in any
