ORDER BY THE REGISTRAR PURSUANT TO RULE 64

I, Lovemore G. Munlo SC, Registrar of the Special Court for Sierra Leone (the "Special Court"),

MINDFUL of the duties and responsibilities of the Registrar under the Statute of the Special Court and the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

NOTING the Order of the President pursuant to Rule 4 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence dated 19 June 2006, ordering that the accused Charles Ghankay Taylor (the "Accused") be transferred to and detained in appropriate detention facilities in The Hague, The Netherlands, in accordance with the conditions set out in the agreements between the Registrar, the International Criminal Court (the "ICC") and the Government of The Netherlands;

NOTING the Memorandum of Understanding regarding Administrative Arrangements between the ICC and the Special Court (the "Memorandum of Understanding"), signed on 13 April 2006;

NOTING FURTHER that under Article 6 of the Memorandum of Understanding, the Accused will have to be detained at the ICC Detention Centre under the ICC's rules of detention and standards under the overall responsibility of the Special Court;

PURSUANT TO Rule 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence

HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- 1. The Accused shall be detained in the ICC Detention Centre;
- 2. The rules of detention and standards of the ICC shall be applicable for the detention of the Accused mutatis mutandis;
- All detention officers of the ICC who for the purposes of this Order shall act as representatives of the Chief of Detention of the Special Court, shall immediately notify the Chief of Detention of the Special Court if they are seized of any motion, request or communication by the Accused, pursuant to the rules of detention and standards of the ICC. The Special Court shall bear the overall responsibility for the Accused.
- 4. The authorities of the ICC shall periodically liaise with the Chief of Detention and the Medical Officer of the Special Court. The Chief of Detention of the Special Court may, in consultation with the ICC, designate members of his staff to be present in the ICC Detention Centre to assist in this process.
- 5. The Complaints Procedure set out in Rule 59 of the Rules of Detention of the Special Court shall be applicable.
