

## I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Prosecution files this motion under Rule 73 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) to request that the Trial Chamber admit into evidence the documents identified in **Annex A** and provided in **Annex B** of this motion (which documents form part of a collection of documents seized from Foday Sankoh’s residence on 8 May 2000 (“**Sankoh Documents**”)) pursuant to: (i) Rule 89(C); or, in the alternative, (ii) Rules 89(C) and 92bis, should the Chamber find that Rule 92bis is also applicable.
2. The Prosecution is mindful of this Chamber’s decision that, where a document is not being tendered through a witness, then the application should be made under Rule 92bis.<sup>1</sup> The Prosecution’s motion for leave to appeal that decision is pending.<sup>2</sup>
3. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the first instance, the Prosecution maintains that the Sankoh Documents are admissible under Rule 89(C) alone for three reasons: Rule 89(C) is the general rule governing admission of evidence and has been used to tender documents absent a witness in other proceedings;<sup>3</sup> Rule 92bis has been amended such that it is now limited to witness statements and transcripts; and Rule 92bis as amended and limited does not apply to documents which were not prepared for the purposes of legal proceedings. In the alternative, Rules 89(C) and 92bis allow the admission of the documentary evidence discussed herein.

## II. APPLICABLE LAW

### Admission under Rule 89(C)

4. The Prosecution relies on and incorporates by reference its submissions made under this heading in its recent similar filings.<sup>4</sup>

### Alternative request for relief: Admission under Rules 89(C) and 92bis

5. The Prosecution relies on and incorporates by reference its submissions made under this heading in its recent similar filings.<sup>5</sup>

### III. SUBMISSIONS ON ADMISSIBILITY OF EVIDENCE

6. As required by SCSL jurisprudence,<sup>6</sup> the Prosecution has made every effort to save the Court from wading through a mountain of material<sup>7</sup> or a mass of undigested paperwork.<sup>8</sup> Therefore, **Annex A** includes a table describing each document<sup>9</sup> and **Annex B** contains a copy of each document.<sup>10</sup> Admission of each document in its entirety is sought.

#### Application for Admission under Rule 89(C)

7. The relevance of each Sankoh Document to the current proceedings and the Second Amended Indictment is identified in **Annex A**. As noted therein, the documents relate to: (i) the chapeau requirements of the crimes charged; (ii) the several forms of liability alleged by the Prosecution in this case; and (iii) the crime base.
8. The material does not impact adversely and unfairly *upon the integrity of the proceedings* nor is it of such a nature that its admission would bring the administration of justice into serious disrepute. As noted in paragraph 1 above, the documents which are the subject of this motion form part of a collection of documents seized from Foday Sankoh's residence. In relation to this fact, should it be required, the Chief of the Evidence Unit is available to testify as to how the OTP obtained these documents and, in this regard, will be the subject of a motion to be filed under Rules 73bis(E) and 92bis. In accordance with the AFRC

Judgment,<sup>11</sup> copies are provided as an accurate reproduction of the original.

9. This Chamber has noted that it “has a discretion under Rule 89(C) to admit any relevant evidence” and “the inability of the Defence to cross-examine such witnesses is a matter that goes to the weight of the evidence, not its admissibility.”<sup>12</sup> In addition, at the ICTY, a report from a member of a commission of experts was admitted despite defence complaints that they were being: “denied the right to cross-examine a paper witness.”<sup>13</sup> In the face of such objections, the Chamber did “take entirely the point made by the Defence, that they cannot cross-examine the 400 witnesses on whose statements this evidence will be based.” But found that “in this Tribunal we admit all types of evidence. The hearsay rule does not apply, but the issue of how much weight is given to this evidence is very much a matter for the Tribunal.”<sup>14</sup> Trial Chamber I has also admitted evidence on a similar basis as the “Chamber is composed of professional judges who are certainly capable of not drawing inferences without proper evidentiary basis or foundation and that the matter of weight to be given to any piece of evidence will be determined at the appropriate time in light of all of the evidence adduced at trial.”<sup>15</sup> It is, therefore, clear that no undue prejudice to the Accused arises from the fact that a document is produced without calling a witness.<sup>16</sup>

#### Alternative request for relief: Application for Admission under Rules 89(C) and 92bis

10. Assuming, *arguendo*, Rule 92bis is applicable, the Prosecution seeks in the alternative to have the Sankoh Documents admitted under Rules 89(C) and 92bis.
11. In relation to relevance, the Prosecution refers to paragraph 7 above.
12. As regards susceptibility of confirmation, the Prosecution is not required to prove that the evidence is in fact reliable at this stage, only that the reliability of the evidence is

susceptible of confirmation.<sup>17</sup> However, notwithstanding this fact and as advised above, evidence included in a separate filing is intended to assist the Chamber in establishing the origin and custody of the Sankoh Documents.

13. In relation to “undue prejudice to the Accused”, the Prosecution refers to paragraphs 8-9 and 12 above.
14. Assuming further, *arguendo*, that the qualification regarding evidence going to proof of the acts and conduct of the accused is still applicable to documents not prepared for the purposes of legal proceedings notwithstanding the May 2007 amendments, the documents which the Prosecution seeks to admit do not go to proof of the acts and conduct of the Accused as that term is defined and limited by the jurisprudence.
15. As regards issues of proximity, while the Documents do concern the acts and conduct of those who might be considered the Accused’s immediately proximate subordinates, the Prosecution relies on its arguments incorporated above at paragraphs 4 and 5. Further, the Sankoh Documents are not being presented to a lay jury, and so will not “impact adversely and unfairly upon the integrity of the proceedings.” Rather, it is in the interests of justice that this relevant evidence is brought before the Chamber, and that the Chamber be allowed to assess the appropriate weight to be given to it at the conclusion of the case.


#### **IV. CONCLUSION**

16. The Prosecution requests that the Trial Chamber admit into evidence the Sankoh Documents identified in **Annex A** and provided in **Annex B** pursuant to: (i) Rule 89(C) as this rule alone has been used at the SCSL to tender documents absent a witness and Rule 92bis has been amended such that it is now limited to witness material and does not apply to documents not prepared for legal proceedings; or, in the alternative, (ii) Rules 89(C) and 92bis, as Rule 92bis is interpreted in paragraphs 15-16 of the UN Documents Motion.

After series of deliberation, members of the Military High Command and the People's War Council of the People's Army have adopted this proposal which with all due respect is being submitted to you for your perusal and timely consideration.

II. MILITARY INTEGRATION

The People's Army deemed it expedient at this time to be tentatively integrated into the Sierra Leone Army which is to be dubbed "National Army". This will alleviate the numerous constraints which continue to bug the People's Army. Should this proposal be accepted we suggest the initial integration of Five Thousand men. In addition, we suggest the occupation of prominent positions by key Commanders of the People's Army in the integrated National Army. This is unequivocally spelled out below:

- (a) Colonel Sam Beckarie, Field Commander of the People's Army, to be the Second-in-Command to the Chief of Defence Staff (C.D.S.)
- (b) Lieutenant Colonel Issa H. Sessay, Battle Group Commander of the People's Army, to be Second-in-Command to the Chief of Army Staff (C.G.A.S.).
- (c) Colonel Isaac Mongue to be Second-in-Command to the Chairman of Joint Security.

III. OCCUPATION OF REMAINING MINISTRIES

It has also been proposed that in order to keep the governmental machinery in motion the remaining Ministries which belong to the People's Army should be occupied by the following people:

- (a) Captain Lawrence Wormaldia, Ministry of Energy and Power.
- (b) Lieutenant Eldred Collins, Ministry of Trade and Industry.
- (c) Lieutenant-Colonel Peter Vandy, Under-Secretary Lands, Housing and Environment.
- (d) Captain Patrick S. Bainda, Under-Secretary, Ministry of Education.

III. SUPREME COUNCIL

A complete list of the members of the Supreme Council will be submitted soon. Colonel Michael Lenin has been named a member of the Supreme Council and the representative of the People's Army in any AERC delegation.




